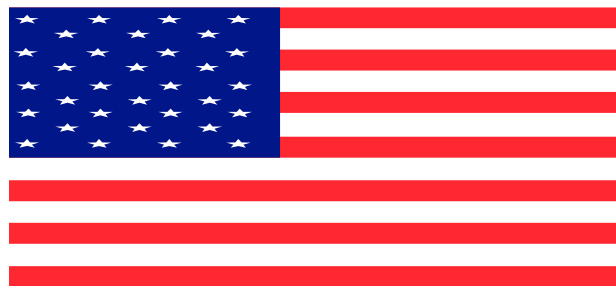

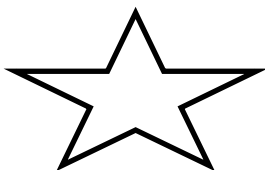

## **\*\*POST 166 HONOR GUARD\*\***

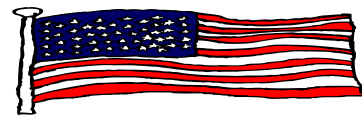

## POST BY-LAW CHANGE

The following proposed By-Law change was approved by the Executive Committee on Tuesday April 8, 2025. It will be voted on at the General Membership Meeting on Wednesday, May 15, 2025.

### **Current:** ARTICLE V: ELECTION OF OFFICERS

3: Post members, in good standing, are eligible to hold elected office. First round nominations for elected positions will open at the regular Post meeting in March, followed by a second round of nominations at the April meeting, after which all nominations will be closed. This will allow ample time for all nominations to be made and all nominees to accept. Nominees must accept the nomination in order for it to be valid and may accept nomination for only one office. Acceptance will be verbal or written notice, reported to and accepted by the Judge Advocate. The Commander is limited to two consecutive terms. Other officers may succeed themselves.

### **Suggested:** ARTICLE V: ELECTION OF OFFICERS

3: Post members, in good standing, after being a member of Post 166 for 1 year are eligible to hold elected office. First round nominations for elected positions will open at the regular Post meeting in March, followed by a second round of nominations at the April meeting, after which all nominations will be closed. This will allow ample time for all nominations to be made and all nominees to accept. Nominees must accept the nomination in order for it to be valid and may accept nomination for only one office. Acceptance will be verbal or written notice, reported to and accepted by the Judge Advocate.

The Commander is limited to two consecutive terms. Other officers may succeed themselves.
